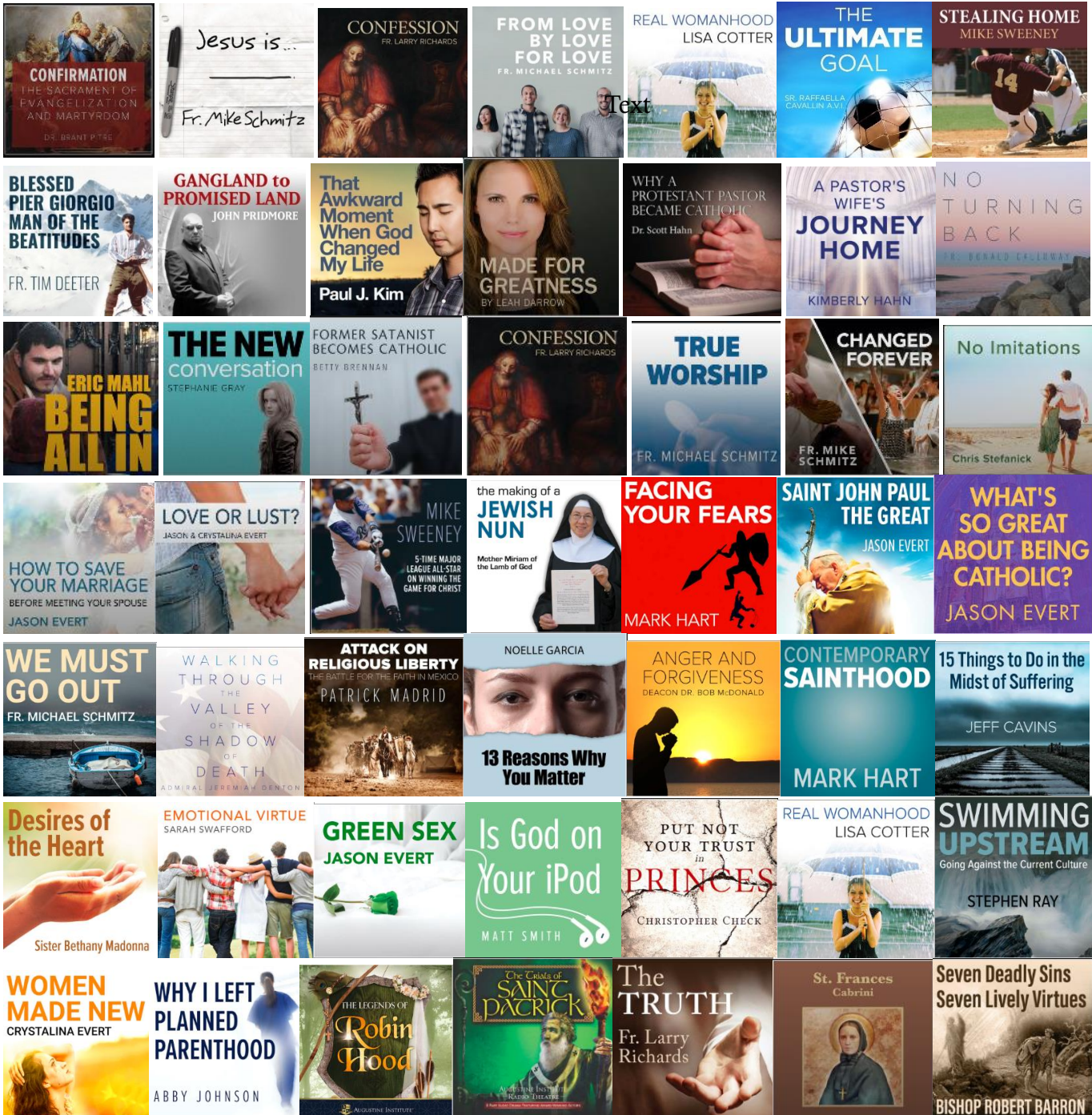

Sponsor Interview:

Now that you have chosen your sponsor, it is time to spend a little more time with him/her to really get to know more about his/her faith journey. After all, the life-long role of your sponsor is to walk with you and support you on your own faith journey! You may find that you already know a lot or that there is a lot that you can learn!

1. How do you pray? Do you have a favorite place to pray or a favorite time to pray? Do you ever find it difficult to pray? When you pray, who do you usually pray to: God, Jesus, The Holy Spirit, Mary, a particular saint? Who or what do you usually pray for?
2. Do you regularly participate in service projects or volunteer opportunities at your parish, work, or in your neighborhood?
Describe what you do and how it impacts your life.
3. Have you ever had a time in your life when you really felt close to God? Tell me about it.
4. Have you ever had a time in your life when you really struggled to believe in God? Tell me about it and how you kept your faith in the end.
5. Who has been a good role model for you to live according to your Catholic faith? What has he/she taught you or shown you? How has he/she deepened your faith?
6. In what ways do you think you still need to grow in your Catholic faith?
7. What is your favorite Scripture passage, verse or story? Tell me why.

Through the Sacrament of Confirmation, the gifts we first received at our Baptism: *Wisdom, Right Judgment (Counsel), Knowledge, Wonder and Awe (Fear of the Lord), Understanding, Courage (Fortitude), Reverence (Piety)* are strengthened and increased within each of us. These seven special gifts represent all of the gifts and blessings that God gives us to lead a good and holy life. They are special graces that are given to us through the Holy Spirit to enable us to respond to God's call to holiness.
